The plant of Impress Diseño Iberia is near Sant Antoni de Vilamajor, some 50 km north-east of the conference hotel. It has four gravure presses, used for printing decorative base paper for laminates, and also manufactures its own inks.

The Hewlett-Packard site in Sant Cugat del Vallès includes the European HQ of their Graphic Solutions business as well as the worldwide HQ of their Large Format and 3D digital printing businesses.



## Barcelona

Barcelona is the capital and largest city of Catalonia, with a population of 1,6 million in the city and over 5 million in the urban area, the sixth most populous in the European Union. Founded as a Roman city in the Middle Ages, today Barcelona is Spain's leading economic and trade fair centre, and a favourite tourist destination. Particularly renowned are the architectural works of Gaudí, which have been designated UNESCO World Heritage Sites, and the art of Miró and Dalí. Barcelona hosted the 1992 Olympic Games, in preparation for which the harbour area was extensively renovated.

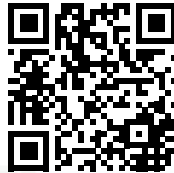
